

2012 Hernando County Fair Youth Livestock Show & Sale Family Living Entry General Rules and Regulations

1. This contest is open to any Hernando County resident - Youth or Adult.
2. All Exhibitors will use the same Entry Form. Division Entries need to have a **"Y"** listed after the entry if you are a Youth Exhibitor, and an **"A"** listed after the entry if you are an Adult Exhibitor. You will be issued entry numbers at the Fairgrounds. Please keep your Claim Stub safe, and bring it with you when picking up your items.



3. All Exhibitors receive a 1 (one) day Pass at exhibit drop-off. If you loose your Exhibitor Pass there is a \$25.00 replacement fee.



4. **ALL YOUTH EXHIBITORS MUST PROVIDE A SELF-ADDRESSED, STAMPED ENVELOPE WITH THEIR ENTRY FORM. (Your Fair Preimum Check will be mailed to you).**

5. Entry drop-off dates are as follows:

Baked Goods & Candy are ONLY going to be accepted for entry on Friday, March 30, 2012 from 1:00 P.M. - 6:00 P.M.

All Other Entries can be submitted on either Friday, March 30, 2012 from 1:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. Or on Saturday, March 31, 2012 from 1:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.

6. All projects exhibited must have been completed by the entrant since last year's fair. The itemes entered should be the best sample of your work and be clean and ready to display to the public. Similar items, such as a set of ceramic houses, can be entered as a set, but will only be eliglble for one ribbon. Special execeptions may be made according to the individual situation.

7. All Art should be framed and ready to hang, (homemade cardboard frames are acceptable). Collections should be ready to display, (in a book, tray, box or other appropriate container).

8. **FOOD PRESERVATION:** Each jar of canned food must have been canned since May 1, 2011. Use clear glass and uniform standard containers of any brand. Items must be sealed for judging. Paraffin is not accepted. All products that have artificial coloring will be disqualified. Judging will be based on the following qualifications: a. Color/clearness; b. Condition and cleanliness of jar and lid; c. Correct amount of headspace; d. Uniformity, ripeness, size; and e. Pack, fullness, uniformity.

9. **BAKED GOODS & CANDY:** a. One (1) slice of a cake, pie or bread is needed for entry and will be judged on the same basis as a whole; b. **A 4 x 6 colored picture, as well as recipe must accompany each product;** c. Only two (2) Biscuits, Cookies, Brownies, etc. are needed for entry; d. No mixes are to be used for entries; and e. Baked goods should be on a sturdy foam plate and covered with clear plastic wrap.

10. Every reasonable effort will be made by the Hernando County Fair Association to protect the property on exhibition, but neither the Hernando County Fair Association, nor those supporting the HCFA will be responsible should loss or damage occur.

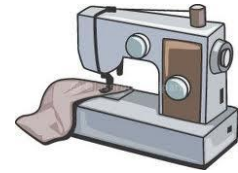
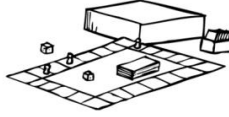
11. Exhibits will be judged by the Modified Danish System. An award of merit ribbon will be presented to the most outstanding exhibit in each class and in each division, if there are enough qualifying entries. Judges decisions are final!

12. The HCFA reserves the right to determine which division of entries will receive premiums, and how much those premiums will be.

13. Entry pick-up date is Sunday, April 15, 2012 from 1:30 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.
