There will be no premiums or prize monies awarded except in Showmanship. Rosettes will be awarded for Grand and Reserve Grand Champion in each division and Best in Show.

The order of the show IS subject to change at the discretion of the show committee.

Animals without papers may not be shown.

We will have a livestock inspector on site during check in.

The following breeds are sanctioned by American Dairy Goat Association (ADGA) and will be shown as listed: Nubian, Nigerian Dwarf, Alpine, Lamancha, Recorded Grade and All Other Purebred. The Junior and Senior Does will be separately sanctioned. ADGA Rules Shall Govern.

SHOW ORDER:

Youth Showmanship

Senior Class – Youth 14 years old to 19 years old

Intermediate Class – Youth 11years old to 13 years old

Junior Class – Youth 8 years old to 10 years old

Pee Wee Class – Youth 5 years old to 7 years old

Junior Pee Wee Class (all entries will receive a prize) Youth under 5 years old

Judging will be based on the ADGA Showmanship Scorecard. Premiums will be awarded. Rosettes and ribbons will be awarded. Winner's certificates available through ADGA. See www.adga.org for more information on the Showmanship requirements. All youth exhibitors will be required to be clean and neat and dressed in white or dark jeans or slacks with a solid white shirt with a white collar. Youth are encouraged to wear FFA or 4-H attire. No caps or hats. Closed-toed shoes or boots are required *no crocks*. Exhibitors not conforming to the dress code will not be allowed to enter the Show Ring. Exhibitors must show a dairy goat officially entered in the open show.

SHOWMANSHIP JUDGING:

- 1. Judging will be based on the ADGA Showmanship Scorecard**
- 2. Ability to show a Dairy Goat**
- 3. Grooming and cleanliness of a goat**
- 4. Ability to answer any questions asked by the judge**
- 5. Knowledge of parts of the goat**
- 6. Neatness and appropriate attire in the show ring**

7. Exhibitors must adhere to the attire guidelines

PREMIUMS FOR YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP ONLY (MINIMUM) – 1st Place will receive a belt buckle.

1st Place - \$40.00

2nd Place - \$30.00

3rd Place - \$20.00

JUNIOR DOE SHOW: Any doe under 24 months of age that has never freshened.

SENIOR DOE SHOW: Any doe that has freshened or is being milked regularly shall compete in the Senior Doe Show. This includes dry and precocious milkers.

Entry Rules and Regulations

1. Entry Forms: ENTRY FORMS WITH FEES MUST BE MAILED AND POSTMARKED OR RECEIVED VIA EMAIL BY MIDNIGHT OF APRIL 11, 2022.

2. **Entry Fees:** There will be a \$10.00 (non-refundable) exhibitor fee and a \$10.00 (non-refundable) registration fee **PER ANIMAL** to be submitted **with entry form. There will be a discount for those who enter more than 10 goats into the show; if entering more than 10 goats entry fee per goat will be \$8.00 per goat.** Payment can be made via PayPal or Check. **TWO EXHIBITOR PASSES WILL BE PROVIDED PER EXHIBITOR.** ENTRY FEES TO THE FAIR ARE \$5.00 FOR ANYONE WHO IS COMING TO WATCH THE SHOW.
3. **Eligibility for Youth Showmanship:** Entries are limited to youth exhibitors 19 years of age as of September 1, 2021.
4. **Fitting and Grooming:** All animals must be fitted and groomed prior to their arrival of the show.
5. **Substitutions:** Substitutions can be made on the day of show.
6. Animals without papers will not be shown. The official registration certificate is required for all animals over 6 months of age or older. A duplicate application for registration stamped by the ADGA office is permissible for animals under 6 months of age.
7. Animals must be naturally polled, dehorned, or dis-budded.
8. Each exhibitor must furnish his/her own pen, care, feed and supplies for your animal. You must clean up your area after release from the show.
9. Exhibitors must maintain proper conduct while exhibiting and showing their animals and while on Fair Grounds Property. Observed infractions will be dealt with by the committee.
10. Tampering with animals is prohibited.
11. Each exhibitor must assume responsibility and liability in the event of loss, death or injury to his/her animal. The Youth Dairy Goat Show Committee and The Hernando County Fair Association are not responsible for the health and safety of any animal entered or exhibited.

HEALTH RULES:

- Health papers are required. All goats consigned for public exhibition in Florida must be accompanied by official certificates of veterinary inspection dated not more than 90 days prior, certifying animals to be free from symptoms of contagious or infectious diseases.
- Goats imported into Florida must have an OCVI dated not more than 30 days prior. Dairy goats originating from Florida (not imported) are exempt from TB/Brucellosis testing requirements.
- All imported dairy goats 6 months of age or older must originate from a certified/accredited herd (with appropriate documentation), or have verifiable, documented negative testing results recorded on the OCVI.
- All animals must be free from clinical symptoms of caseous lymphadenitis. Animals showing clinical symptoms of this disease will not be allowed to enter the area of activity or to become associated with animals entered by other exhibitors. With reference to CL, clinical symptoms is the term used to define enlargements of the lymph

nodes, whether draining or not. Evidence of incised lymph nodes will be interpreted as prima facia evidence of CL in the animal under scrutiny.

- All animals must be free of all contagious diseases.
- No animals are to leave the trailer until they are checked by the Ag Health Inspector.

Hernando County Fair Association Herdsman Respect Policy

The Dairy Goat Committee will treat exhibitors, parents, fellow volunteers and members of the public with respect and will expect the same in return.

The Dairy Goat Committee will not conduct business with those who use obscenities or otherwise speak in a demanding, loud, insulting or threatening manner.

Volatile, hostile or aggressive actions and words will not be tolerated, and individuals who engage in these activities may face penalties up to, and including, criminal prosecution.

This policy promotes mutual respect, civility and orderly conduct among all committee members, exhibitors and parents. It is intended to maintain, to the extent that is possible and reasonable, a safe, harassment-free show & sale for exhibitors, families and volunteers, that is free of disruptive, demeaning, intimidating, threatening or aggressive behaviors.
